2019 Board of Director Candidates

The Nominating Committee submitted the following names of candidates to serve on the Hughes Federal Credit Union board of directors. There are three openings on our board. The nominees with the three highest number of votes will serve a three-year term.

Ashesh Bhalala*

Ashesh Bhalala has been a member of Hughes Federal Credit Union for 33 years. Mr. Bhalala is a Senior Manager at Raytheon Missile Systems Company where he has worked in engineering design and development since 1985. He has more than 21 years of management experience at Hughes/Raytheon.

Mr. Bhalala received his Bachelor of Science and Master of Science degrees in Electrical Engineering from the University of Arizona. 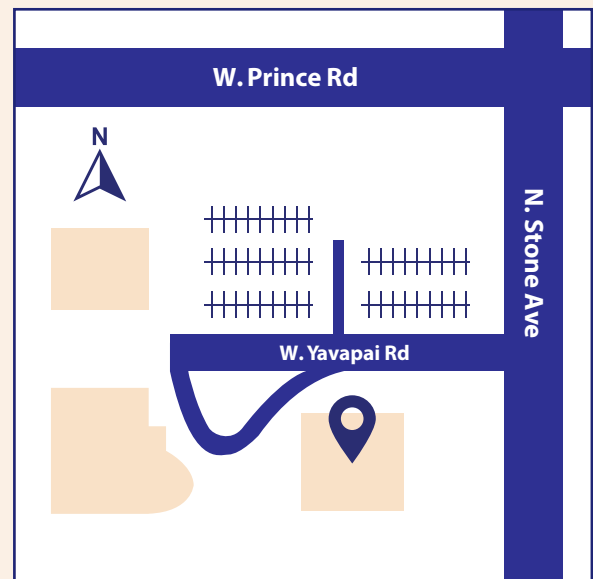
Members must be present to vote. One vote per primary member. No nominations are accepted from the floor.
